Creativity and originality of the product presented.</p> <p>iv. Innovativeness.</p> <p>v. Stall presentation.</p> <p>vi. Was the product hand crafted or repackaged to make it their own.</p> <p>vii. 12.	How will the Winner/s be informed?	The winner will be selected by the Judges using the above criteria on the day of the market.

		<p>The Landlord will use all reasonable efforts to contact the Winner during trading hours (10-3pm) on-site at the market</p> <p>If the Landlord is unable to contact or reach the Winner within 7 (Seven) days of having announced the Winner, the Entry by that person will be disqualified.
